FEES AND MAINTENANCE

Home and EU Students

All Home and EU students on the FULL TIME COURSES are eligible for fees funding. Applicants should note that there are strict regulations regarding residency which must be met in order to qualify for Home Student status. All EU students who are offered a place at RADA are required to verify their EU status through the European Team office prior to the place offer being confirmed. Non graduate students may apply to their LEA for additional support towards the mandatory student contribution (currently £3070 per year). This application is means tested. All full time students are eligible to apply through their LEA for a student loan. This application is also means tested.
